

Temporary Accommodation for Homeless ~ Public Image Campaign

Temporary Accommodation for Homeless ("TAFH") targets to help 100 people who are street sleepers and COVID-19 made lives more difficult for them. Since October, it appeared in various media including: (1) Television, (2) Online talk show and (3) Newspaper. In addition, for free, MTR provided 300 display on panels along trackside for 1 month; while KMB, for free, provided us with 1 bus with full bus display for 1 month. This Campaign increased awareness to more than 1 million+ in HKSAR and valued at HK\$3 million+.









On 5th December, winners were announced. 80 videos were submitted and 35 teams were commended; teachers for these teams further received financial aid from "Stage of Love & Legacy Funding" aggregating to HK\$105,000.

Through the arrangement of our partnering NGO, YWCA, 32 hampers consisting of rice, oil, soya source, biscuit, canned food, Hi-Calcium Soya Drink and finger-strengthener were donated to the elderlies. We were separated into 8 teams to meet the social distance requirement and each team met 4 elderlies. Each elderly shared their unique stories and we had a wonderful morning connecting with them. If each of us spend some time per day around them, we could increase happiness in our community and develop rapport with these people who silently supported the success in HKSAR. Inclusive of co-ordination, a total of 135 man-hours was committed into this service project.














What's Next? Career Pathfinders ~ 5th March 2021
