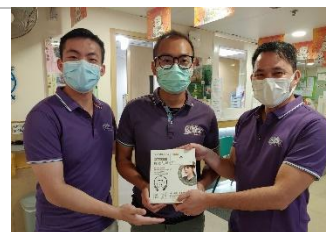

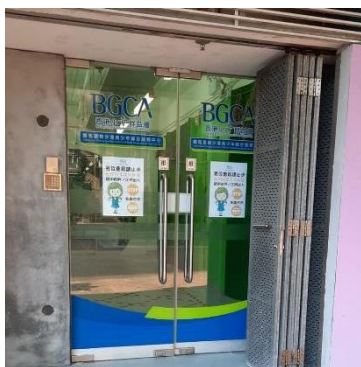

International Service Project 2020-21 with Rotary Club of Nairobi - Langata in Oloomaiyana, Kajiado County, Kenya

This IS project which was held in IPP Colin's year jointly with RC Braemar Hill. The project closing ceremony was held on 12-6-2021. Oloomayiana is in Iyarat sublocation of Kajiado County. According to the last census report the population for community members residing Iyarat sublocation 15,000 people with a population of approximately 5,000 people within Oloomayiana area. The area is around 130km from Nairobi and is inhabited by the pastoralist Maasai community.



Why Joint project : Referred by PN Hazel Ip of Rotary Club of Braemar Hill who is working in Kenya

The original source of water for the community came from three private dams and one community dam. These dams are all seasonal. The dams are shared among livestock, wild animals, and the community for domestic use. This water is not treated and is often taken as it is.

Under Water, Sanitation & Hygiene area of focus, RCL installed a water harvesting system around the clinic & the school & provided storage for harvested water with two big capacity tanks. This allowed the community to harvest water as we worked on a long term solution.

In phase 2, with the support of the Kenya Defence Forces we have managed to provide running water to the community. The Kenya Defence Forces supported us by drilling a borehole with a final depth of 280m with a tested yield of 7,200 ltrs/hr, installed 20,000lt water tanks, fitted of a solar pump & constructed a pump house as well as provided water yields & quality assessment. KDF further piped the borehole water 4kms to the Oloomayiana Community Centre.

RCL then partnered with Vitol Foundation, **Rotary Clubs of Hong Kong Northpoint & RC Braemar Hill** installed a smart water dispensing system via a water kiosk that uses smart card & a token retailing system. This system will help guarantee prudent management of resources accrued from water sales.
