## Developing Inclusiveness with beneficiaries at Wellness Manor





On 9 October 2022, members from Rotary Club of Hong Kong North Point were invited to join the Birthday Party held in Wellness Manor ("NAAC-WM") which was organized by The Neighbourhood Advice-Action Council ("NAAC") and George A. Spence Foundation ("GASF"). NAAC-WM is a hostel for moderately mental handicapped persons which provides short term residential for people with disabilities in the community so their family could have a short break or may attend to their personal matters.

With beneficiaries from NAAC-WM, our Rotarians enjoyed time of fellowship and inclusion through fun-time of singing and dancing followed by cake cutting plus afternoon tea together. While the gathering was only 2hrs, friendships were built. One beneficiary whispered into one of our Rotarian to say "my birthday soon"; despite of limited words, it was so heartwarming they wanted to chat with us and wish to extend friendship into the future. The afternoon tea was arranged by a social enterprise which supports HKSAR's local economy.







#### International Service - Kenya 3-12-2022

We joined with RC Braemar Hill partnering and RC Langata-Nairobi with US\$ 1,000 budget. It was the 3rd years for joint international projects. Thanks to P Hazel Ip who incharge the project.

We donated laboratory equipment and reagent to benefit 18000 ppl including pregnant women and children in Kangemi slum. Value around US\$ 20,000 in total.

We also provided 2 years after sales service for free to the hospital. Special thanks to our medical partners, we are able to donate HB meter and strip which benefits over 18,000 ppl in Kangemi area. On Dec 3, 2022 we handover medical equipment valued 20,000 USD to the mission hospital- ST Joseph The worker catholic Health center. Thanks to the Rotary Club of Shanghai Gubei too.
















#### Sponsorship of Interactive White Board to CCC Kwei Wah Shan College

Having our PGD CP Eric led the club installation, our club recognised PP Peter Pang as our Club President 22-23.


After President Peter introduced himself @family, @work and @Community services, P Peter introduced the core committee members, a great team to serve the club till end of this Rotary year.



### Rotary D3450 The One Humanitarian Award 2022 Gala Dinner









Our Club is the Bronze sponsor for the One Award and committed for 3 years.

THE ONE, was conceptualized and founded by Past District Governor Dr. David Harilela in 2011 and is the first international humanitarian award launched by Rotary International District 3450.

This award aims to find the unsung hero of today by accessing the powerful Rotary network of over 1.2 million people. As signified by the Rotary motto, Rotary's main objective is service — in the community, in the workplace, and throughout the world.

THE ONE Hong Kong Humanitarian Annual Award (hereafter "THE ONE HK") seeks to find and honor unsung heroes in Hong Kong who are doing good for and within the community.

The Rotary D3450 awards, which returned after three-year, was co-founded in 2012 by PDG David Harilela. It was created with the goal of empowering and rewarding individuals who dedicate their lives to serving others in need. The evening saw HK\$2.5 million awarded to six humanitarians from Hong Kong, Nepal and Thailand. These included Avis Rideout, a missionary based in Thailand who works with HIV-infected and abandoned children; and Kitty Poon, founder of the Hong Kong-based charity LoveXpress Foundation, which serves the special needs community. The cash prizes will go towards their work and humanitarian efforts.










